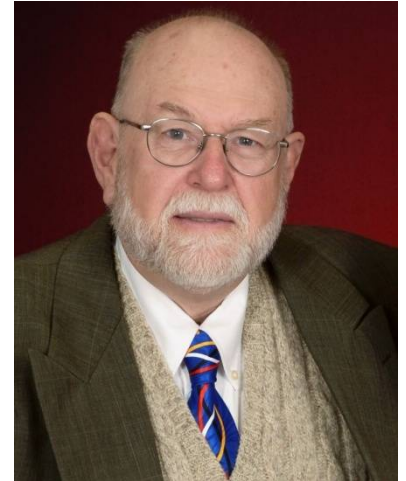

George A. Yerion, PLS began his career in the Engineering Design Unit of the USDA Soil Conservation Service (SCS) in Indianapolis, IN. Responsible for reviewing design drawings for compliance with SCS drafting standards, Mr. Yerion developed a desire for quality of product that remains an integral part of all of his work.

He has been privileged to have opportunities to expand his knowledge and experience throughout his professional career. While at the SCS he worked on PL-566 flood and erosion control projects in the field and in the office. In the private sector he held positions in surveying and construction inspection on St. Louis public works projects including the Bi-State Bus Garage, the Chouteau Avenue Bridge reconstruction design project, the Jefferson Expansion Museum (Arch) parking garage, long-term parking and apron expansion at Lambert-St. Louis International Airport, and the Wharf Street Tourist District street improvements. His work in CAD resulted in his promotion to Land Development CADD Manager and later Computer System Manager, where he provided technical support and training for 14 CADD workstations and field-to-finish automation for 3 survey crews.
